CENSUS 2020

The 2020 Census is mandated in the US Constitution and the results are used for reapportionment of the US House of Representatives and for redistricting of state and federal legislative districts.

The importance of the 2020 census is that up to \$2,000 of federal funding will be lost for each person not counted; as well as upwards of \$20,000 of federal funding lost every ten years.

The 2020 Census data will also guide the distribution of approximately \$675 billion of federal funds and grants for schools, hospitals, roads, and public works projects. Locally, the data will be important for helping businesses and school make decisions about how to invest resources to most effectively serve the public.

Bland County passed a Proclamation making March 12, 2020, Census Awareness Day

Bland County has also established a Complete Count Committee to help with the goal of dissemination of 2020 Census information to the general public, encouraging all residents to participate in events and initiatives that will raise the overall awareness of the 2020 Census and increase participation, provide Census advocates to speak to community organizations and events, provide support for census takers as they help the community complete an accurate count, and strive to achieve a complete and accurate count of all people within the County of Bland.

The Complete Count Committee will also set up Census Pop-up events throughout the county to help with entering Census information. The first event will be held: March 20, 2020 from 2:00 pm—5:00 pm at the Bland County Library.

March 12-20, 2020 - An invitation postcard to **respond online** to the 2020 Census (Some households will also receive paper questionnaires)

March 16-24, 2020 - A reminder letter

April 8-16, 2020 - A reminder letter and paper questionnaire

April 20-27 - A final reminder postcard before census taker follows up in person

FIREWISE PROGRAM

New River – Highlands RC&D Council, VA Dept of Forestry and Local Homeowners Work Together To Be Firewise.

What is Firewise? Firewise is a call to action for homeowners and communities to educate themselves about the challenges of living in or near woodlands and reducing their wildfire risk. Learning is not enough; homeowners and communities must take action. Involving the local citizens, local organizations, state and federal partners is critical to this work. Firewise principles, including landscape design, vegetation management and building design all help protect citizens, emergency responders, homes and our natural resources from the risks of wildfires

Funding for demonstration and pilot projects is made available to the Council from the VA Dept of Forestry. These funds are part of an overall grant to the State from the USDA Forest Service to mitigate the risk of wildfires.


Before any funding is approved, a written wildfire risk assessment plan must be conducted for the individual home or the entire community. These plans identify areas of wildfire risk and areas where improvements could be made to reduce the risk.

Once these plans are written and approved the RC&D can begin working with private contractors and residents.





